All of RVRN's recent growth has given us time to reflect on our expansion in the past five years. In that time, RVRN's programs have quadrupled in number; our network of families has tripled in size; and we've gone from offering programs 3 months out of the year to offering them 11 months out of the year! We hear from parents and caregivers that it can be hard for RVRN loved ones to socialize and practice interpersonal skills in large groups. In response, we created our newest program—Peer Connect. Participants get to share their favorite music and activities, while making new CS friends. Each hangout is customized to the interests of the group. They meet once a week in a four-week session.




