PROGRAM REPORT Work Experience Program, Peer Connect, Loved One Gatherings

This year marked the second year of RVRN's pilot **Work Experience Program**, creating opportunities for loved ones to serve the Christian Science (CS) community. This year's program doubled in size as *six* trainees spent three weeks at the A/U Ranches serving as the Lodge Crew for Session 1. They learned work-, interpersonal-, and life-skills in a supportive, CS atmosphere. We are grateful to collaborate with Adventure Unlimited in giving trainees an opportunity to let their light shine! One of the job coaches shared how *she* was impacted: "I'm so grateful to have witnessed so much growth from the trainees and to have been part of an amazing atmosphere with an outpouring of love, warmth, and an **overwhelming sense of joy**."

We're also excited to share – RVRN's first session of our pilot **Peer Connect** took place in May. Loved ones enjoyed "hanging out" together online, getting to know one another, sharing favorites, and practicing social skills in an uplifting atmosphere. Finally, Session 2 is underway of our ever-popular **Loved One Gatherings**, led by staff from CedarS Camps. Participants enjoy Bible Lesson fun, music, friendship—
